

2023 ANZCCART Conference CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

ANZCCART is now accepting abstracts from anyone interested in speaking at the 2023 Conference, which will be held in Adelaide from 8th to 10th August 2023.

PRESENTATION TOPICS:

Consideration will be given to presentations on any topic relevant to ethical, social or scientific issues relating to the use and wellbeing of animals in research and teaching.

Presentations must be suitable for a lay audience.

LENGTH OF PRESENTATIONS:

The program will accommodate presentations of the following durations (including questions):

- 15 minutes
- 30 minutes
- 45 minutes

Please note that the Conference organisers may request a different duration to that requested by the presenter due to programing constraints or other reasons.

CONFERENCE REGISTRATION FOR PRESENTERS:

ANZCCART is not able to offer complimentary accommodation or flights for the Conference, however, we are able to offer presenters a one-day Conference registration at no charge on the day of their presentation. The one-day registration includes Conference material, morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea; attendance at the Welcome Reception or Conference Dinner is not included.

Online options will also be available and the complimentary one-day registration will apply on the day of your presentation.

Presenters wishing to attend on additional days either in person or online will be required to pay the registration fee for those days.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS FOR CONSIDERATION:

If you are interested in presenting at the 2023 ANZCCART Conference, please [email](#) ANZCCART with an abstract of up to 350 words and the preferred duration of your proposed presentation no later than **24th February 2023**. Please note that all abstracts are welcome however inclusion in the Conference Program is at the discretion of the Board and Conference Organising Committee.

You will be notified of whether your abstract has been accepted no later than **31st March 2023**. Presenters whose abstract has been accepted will be offered the choice of including either their abstract or a longer summary of their talk of up to 1,000 words for inclusion in the Conference Proceedings no later than **14th April 2023**. When submitting your abstract, please note that ANZCCART is also currently exploring a special Journal issue based on conference papers for publication.
